WWCM is fully funded by donations from our local community, grants, and our signature Neighbors Helping Neighbors fundraiser held each year.

Our volunteers are trained in responding to the emergency needs of visitors quickly and compassionately while maintaining confidentiality. In the 1980's, our founder, Antoinette Clark began on a journey that would lead to the creation of WWCM. She wouldn't let anything deter her quest to support those neighbors struggling financially, even lobbying public officials and utility departments to adopt changes that benefitted indigent clients. She also went to speak at other local churches and created a successful ecumenical community effort to carry out her vision.
